



This is how I set up Corel to get all these questions we like answers to. I will first explain what I do then show you. This is "Setting Up Corel Draw". I will show you 4-14 and explain 15-17 and on.

First click on "window"

Then click on "Color Palettes".

Put a check next to "Trumatch Colors".

This will put a palette on the far right of your screen.

This is the same in most of all the Corel Draw Programs.

This is for Corel Draw 4-14.

Now to see how to get and use screen match colors.

Click on "Tools".

Click on "Visual Basics".

Click on "Play".

Next to "VBA Project" click the down arrow and choose "global Macros".

Next click "Run".

Make sure that the Trumatch palette is selected and your spacing is 1 (not 20)

Next click on OK.

After this runs save it so you can pull it up and use it to match colors.

Corel Draw 15-17 and on.

Tools.

Macros.

Run Macros

Next to "VBA Project" click the down arrow and choose "Global Macros:.

Run.

Trumatch and Spacing 1.

OK.
