



Setting up Corel Draw part 2

The reason for using Global Macros and Trumatch colors is that they never change from one version of Corel to another version of Corel. They all use the same CMYK colors but Palettes vary in different versions of Corel Draw. This is why they always have palettes from older Corel versions in newer ones. You can also pull up the saved swatches and pick colors out that you want. Each color has a number that can be brought up and you can color fill with that color. You see the colors on the right side of the screen are not the color you always get. If I pick a color it then goes through a palette that is selected and can be changed. You need make a loop so the color goes through the right palette. I am going to show you how that is done. The good thing is that doing this stays set until you change it. Watch Lesson 2.
